

# The Walks of The Great House

## 1 The Great House Circular Stroll

Distance: 1.5 miles (2.5 km)  
 Time: 0.5 - 1 hours  
 Description: A relatively short and easy ramble, taking in the immediate surroundings of The Great House.

## 2 The Cowlick of Hawkhurst

Distance: 2.5 miles (4 km)  
 Time: 1 - 1.5 hours  
 Description: Enjoy this pleasant local walk, viewing the fields of the English Weald, the neighbourhood of the village of Hawkhurst and if you are lucky, even alpacas.

## 3 The Four Wents Walk

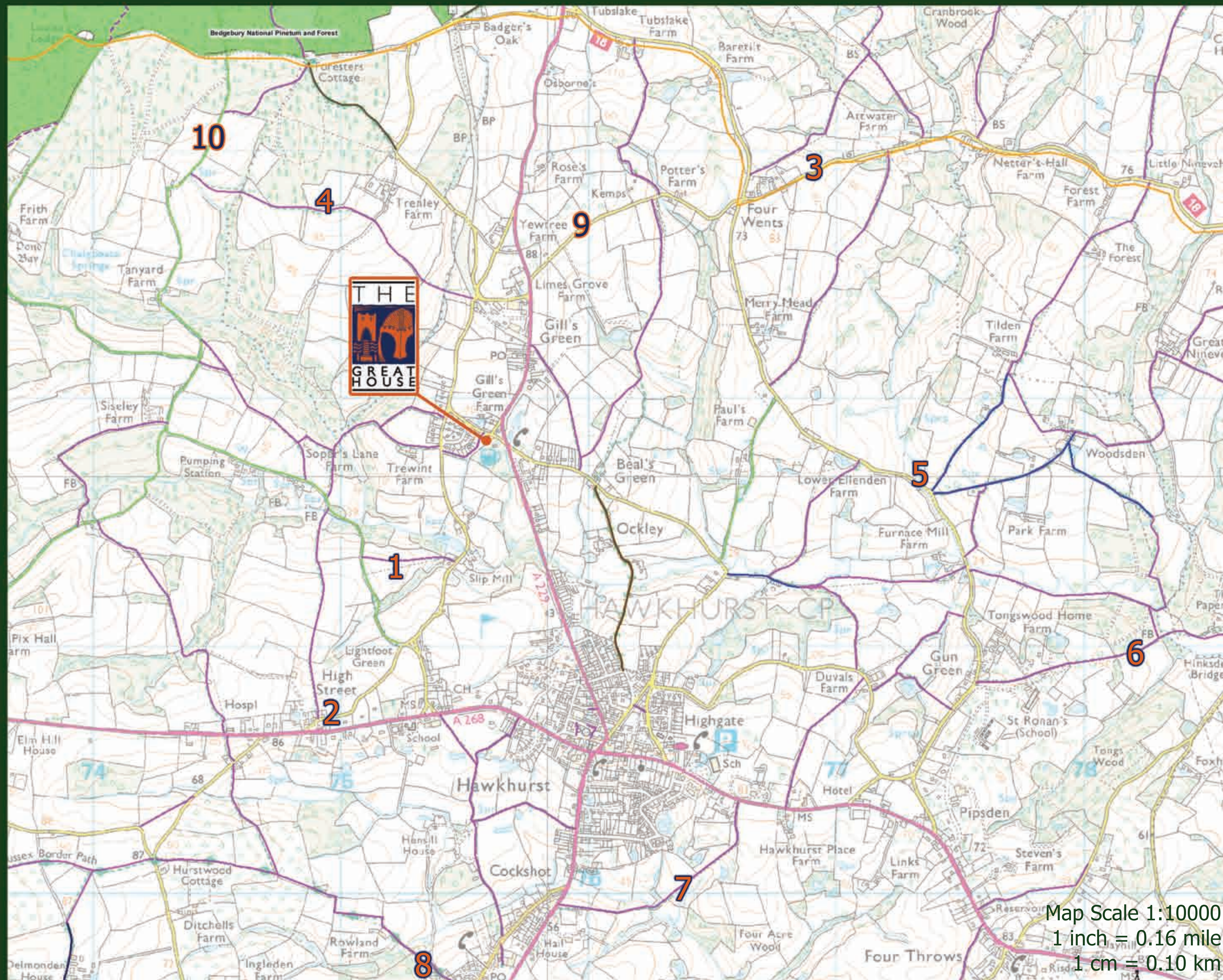
Distance: 3 miles (5 km)  
 Time: 1.5 - 2 hours  
 Description: This walk crosses many fields and includes an opportunity to see the Four Wents, a hop and fruit farm surrounded by woods, shaws and tall hedges.

## 4 Through Western Lands

Distance: 3.5 miles (5.5 km)  
 Time: 1.5 - 2 hours  
 Description: Heading to the west of The Great House, enjoy a trek across fields of the countryside, and the views that the west has to offer.

## 5 Through Eastern Lands

Distance: 4 miles (6 km)  
 Time: 1.5 - 2 hours  
 Description: An interesting hike on the eastern side, sample a touch of Hawkhurst, passing local farms along the way.



## 6 A Taste of the Far East

Distance: 4.5 miles (7 km)  
 Time: 2 - 2.5 hours  
 Description: A further eastern walk, passing the grounds of St Ronan's school, through the eastern forest and alongside a stream.

## 7 The Small Hawkhurst Ring

Distance: 5 miles (8 km)  
 Time: 2 - 2.5 hours  
 Description: A perfect way to see what Hawkhurst has to offer, circling the village centre.

## 8 The Great Hawkhurst Ring

Distance: 8 miles (13 km)  
 Time: 3.5 - 4.5 hours  
 Description: Allow time to complete the longest and most challenging walk around Hawkhurst, completing a full circle of the surrounding areas and landmarks.

## 9 The Great Family Walk

Distance: 3.5 miles (5.5 km)  
 Time: 1.5 - 2 hours  
 Description: An enjoyable local stroll. Ideal for families with dogs and small children with no gates or styles, following mainly roads so practical even in bad weather. Wheelchair accessible.

## 10 The 'No Barrier' Great Walk

Distance: 5 miles (8 km)  
 Time: 2 - 2.5 hours  
 Description: There are no barriers on this very scenic adventurous walk, which takes you to the corner of Bedgebury forest. Wheelchair accessible.

Manage all 10 and be rewarded! Ask staff for details.
