The Bridleways Walk

Walk overview:

Distance: 3.5 miles (5.5 km)

Time: 1.5 – 2 hour

Description: A 'no barriers' (no styles or hurdles) walk which circles The Gun. The majority of this walk leads along bridleways, so can get very muddy in bad weather!

Leave The Gun, turn right onto the road and immediately turn left onto the concrete panel road (1) opposite The Gun car park. Follow this road through Strood Farm (2), go through a metal gate and keep walking along the bridleway (3) until the next gate (4). Walk through it and continue straight until you reach a road.

Turn right onto the road and keep walking along it for 0.3 mile (500m) until a crossroad with a bridleway (there is a 'Public bridleway' stone on the right, but it's not easy to find...). Turn right onto the bridleway and follow it until it becomes a track. Walk along the track past a couple of buildings until you reach a road.

Turn right onto the road and follow it for 0.4 mile (600m) until a crossroad with a bridleway (you pass a 'Pick Hill' signpost on the left and later you pass a house on the left). Turn left onto the bridleway (you can see a wooden 'Bridleway' signpost) and follow it (5) until you reach a road.

Turn right onto the road (6) and keep walking along it until you reach a main road with a white signpost. Turn right onto the road (follow the direction 'Horam' and 'Heathfield') and go back to The Gun.
